Amendment to Tariff Order 2009-10

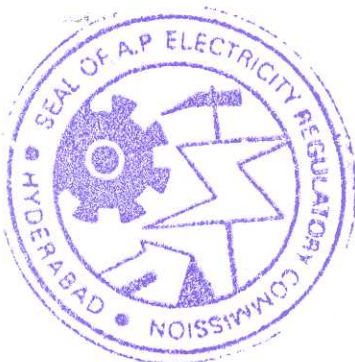
1. M/s APCPDCL requested the Commission to issue amendment/addendum with reference to W.P.No.14961 of 2009 vide letter dated 19-11-2009.
2. The Discom stated that the clause 6 of General conditions of HT supply, gives the meaning that Excess RMD over CMD should be above 100% (200% of CMD) to levy penal charges for exceeding the Contracted Demand.
3. If the consumer is allowed to consume 'Demand' up to 200% of CMD (Excess RMD over 100% CMD) without proper approval, it would lead to over burdening of the lines and power transformers which is not desirable for safe operation of the system.
4. The intention of the Commission is to restrict such consumers to utilise the allocated contracted demand only. The objective of the Commission is not to earn revenue for DISCOMs. The Commission approved the penal charges such that it should act as deterrent on those consumers who exceeds the Contracted Demand.
5. The word 'Excess' was a typographical mistake and the Commission recognised the wrong meaning conveyed by the word 'Excess' and issues the following amendment to Clause 6 of General Conditions of HT Supply of Annexure-D of Tariff Order 2009-10.

Amendment to tariff order 2009-10:

In the heading of column1 of clause 6 of General Conditions of HT Supply of Annexure-D, the word "Excess" shall be omitted.
